**Threads Across Nebraska:** Report given by LeAnne Killion. Threads was held October 14 & 15, 2016 at Buffalo County Fairgrounds. 175 quilts were on display from the Quilt Guilds in Nebraska. This is the first year that classes were given. Friday had 500 in attendance and Saturday was slower. Average attendance appeared to be the same as last year 855. No profit report at this time. **QNE 16**: The hotel was accommodating. The Vendors were very happy. National Teachers were wonderful to work with. The books have been audited by Janet Kugler. Profit for the convention is \$16,000+.

**QNE 17**: Report submitted by Denise Weibel-Rychek, Rita Weber and Leslie Martin. The theme, National Teachers, Quilt History Day teacher and challenge quilt criteria was unveiled at QNE 16 in Lincoln. Recruitment has started for various positions, menus are being set, and work on the budget is getting started.

Jan would encourage the NSQG to consider these problems and ask that perhaps since the State Fair has a

good storage room in the offices in the Nebraska Building on the Fairgrounds that we store State Fair photos in Grand Island. There was discussion on having a copy of pictures to the State Fair. This is going to be tabled to discuss at another meeting.
