## THE LEGACY QUILT

In March of 2009, Peg Pennell was approached to design and make a quilt to be used on stage in the final act of the play "Quilters" at the Omaha Community Playhouse. The quilt needed to be of mammoth proportions, nearly 14' square, to be seen on stage. The play used numerous traditional quilt blocks to tell the story of a pioneer woman and her six daughters living on the American Frontier.

By April, Peg agreed to tackle the quilt. Based on the blocks from the play, Peg designed the quilt and enlisted her quilting friends to help her make the blocks. Peg then assembled the top and sent it to longarm quilter, Connie Kleinschmidt. From the start of the design to finished quilt in just three months! Fabrics used were to be "true to the time" yet needed to be larger in scale to show up on stage. Several local shops generously donated supplies towards the making of the quilt. When the quilt was unfurled at the end of the play, it was received with gasps of joy, making it worth every minute.

# The International Quilt Study Center



The International Quilt Study Center at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln (UNL) was formed in 1997 as a result of the generous gift of nearly 950 quilts from the Ardis & Robert James Collection, along with a substantial pledge of financial support.

As a result of the James' generosity and vision, the International Quilt Study Center at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln was formed. The Center's mission is to encourage the interdisciplinary study of all aspects of quilting worldwide and to foster the preservation of this important cultural tradition through the collection, conservation and exhibition of quilts and related materials. The mission of the International Quilt Study Center & Museum is to collect, preserve, study, exhibit, and promote discovery of quilts and quilting traditions from many cultures, countries and time periods.

Today the International Quilt Study Center collection totals over 2,300 quilts, from 24 countries, dating from the early 1700s to the present.

The International Quilt Study Center & Museum is on the University of Nebraska-Lincoln East Campus at 33rd and Holdrege Streets.
