



NSQG Board Meeting October 19, 2020 Held electronically due to Covid-19

NSQG President, Karen Ruwe, called an electronic board meeting due to COVID-19. It was decided that in the best interest of the board member's the meeting not be held in person. Each executive board member responded to the meeting.

On [October 19, 2020](#), the board of directors for Nebraska State Quilt Guild elected Kelly Thomalla and Mary Arthur to serve as the co-chairs for QuiltNebraska 2022. They will assume all duties as written in the QuiltNebraska Chairperson(s) agreement they signed.

The board of directors also elected Leslie Martin, Denise Rycek Wiebel and Rita Weber to serve as co-chairs in 2023. They will also assume the duties as written in the QuiltNebraska Chairperson(s) agreement they signed.

The board of Directors discussed the bank signature cards and whose name should appear on ones for QuiltNebraska and Nebraska State Quilt Guild. The vote was to have the presidents name included on both bank cards. In 2019 the board decided to keep an open account for QuiltNebraska. Each year's co-chairs would update the names on the banks signature card and be able to use the funds immediately. This was not working as planned. The board discussed, voted on and approved a motion to close the current bank account and allow each years co-chairs the authority to open an account at a bank of their choice, close the account at the end of QuiltNebraska and return any unused funds to the current NSQG treasurer.
