Modern quilting, surface design techniques and sharing her love of quilting and history through volunteerism and workshops are Sheila's passion!

At the International Quilt Museum, she has chaired National Quilting Day since its inception in 2009, volunteers, teaches My Doll and I, quilting and printmaking workshops to children and adults and is past President of FRIENDS of IQM. She is a Nebraska State Quilt Guild Hall of Fame recipient and Education Chair, a Life Member recipient and past President of Lincoln Quilters Guild and past President of Lincoln Modern Quilt Guild. She has lead workshops at QuiltNebraska, the IQM, History Nebraska, Asian Community Center, quilt guilds and chairs Discover Nebraska presentations for 4th graders since 2001. She was recognized as an Admiral in the Great Navy of the State of NE for being NSQG's NE 150 Quilt Competition Chair. During the Pandemic, she led Lincoln Covid Sewists (110 volunteers), who made and donated PPE including over 37,000 masks, 585 surgical scrub caps, and 269 hospital gowns to over 75 organizations. She constructed two giant "Mask Up" quilts that were donated to the IQM and History Nebraska. She received the Heritage Hero Award from History Nebraska for her work. Small group friendships are treasured as her small group Material Girls was formed in 1999 and Fiber Works in 2009.
